Case Study: Nursing Home Fire February, 2025



Mount Carmel, Pennsylvania
 Saturday, January 4, 2025, just before 8:00 am a fire started at the Mount Carmel Senior Living Community
• It was a three-alarm fire, that included the transport of 12 residents, three staff members and five first responders; 19 patients were treated for minor injuries, and one staff member was hospitalized for smoke inhalation
The fire was contained in about one hour
 Believe the fire originated in a hallway
 Displaced residents were placed in another facility
Impacts:
 Patient evacuation – physical and mental impairments HAZMAT concerns Displaced residents
